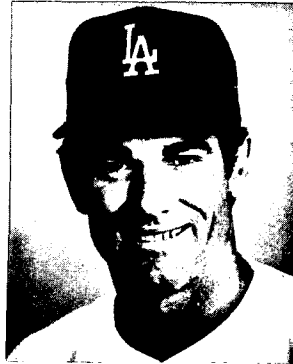

Honorary Chairman

Steve Garvey, outstanding 1st baseman for the Los Angeles Dodgers, has been selected by the Board of Directors of the California Police Athletic Federation to be the first Honorary Chairman of the C.P.A.F. ASSOCIATES.

Steve has been a long time supporter of law enforcement and learned of the Police Olympics through a friend, Lt. Bob Jones of the San Diego Police Department, who has competed in and coordinated Police Olympic events. Steve's enthusiasm to become a part of this program soared.

Informal meetings were held with Steve and his agent, Jerry Kapstein, and the concept of the ASSOCIATES began to jell.

For some time the C.P.A.F. Board had recognized the need to raise funds to promote police athletic games, including the Police Olympics. Several large corporations had already displayed an interest in donating funds. It was now a "natural." Steve Garvey, whose name and reputation is known worldwide teaming up with police officers to promote police physical fitness and athletic programs. Thus, the birth of the California Police Athletic Federation ASSOCIATES and the appointment of Steve Garvey as its first Honorary Chairman.

Steve Garvey's ability to excel as an athlete goes back to 1966 when he was named Athlete of the Year at Chamberlain High School in Tampa, Florida. He was drafted by the Minnesota Twins out of high school but chose not to sign. Instead, he entered Michigan State where he played football and became an All American baseball player. In June of 1968, Steve became the Dodgers #1 selection in the Free Agent Draft.

Steve has six 200 hit seasons to his credit which is exceeded by only seven players in major league history: Pete Rose (10), Ty Cobb (9), Lou Gehrig (8), Willie Keeler (8), Paul Waner (8), Charles Gehringer (7) and Roger Hornsby (7).

In 1981 he played in all 110 Dodger games to run his consecutive game streak to 945 which ranks 5th on the all-time major league list. He also earned National League all star honors for the eighth straight season.

Steve has numerous other records and accomplishments to his credit, including the club home run record (20) at Dodger Stadium in 1979; named MVP in 1974 and 1978 all star games and was the National League MVP in 1974. His 33 homers in 1978 set a new L.A. record. He has earned four gold gloves for fielding excellence - we could go on and on.

In addition to Steve being a long time supporter of law enforcement, his grandfather, Joseph Patrick Garvey, was a member of the Rockville Center Police Department in New York.

What is the California Police Athletic Federation (CPAF)?

The California Police Athletic Federation is a non-profit corporation composed of eight members of the Board of Directors, representing all sections of the State of California. The State has been divided into four sections so that representation can be had from officers living in the section he represents.

Bob has been a CPAF director for five years having joined the Board in 1976 following the Police Olympics in San Jose, which he coordinated. Linda Gisburne, Bob's wife, was very active in assisting Bob in 1976 and continues her active involvement. Since 1977 all police olympic applications have been processed by the CPAF and the Gisburnes have the primary responsibility for this task. Bob is a 17 year veteran of San Jose Police Department and is assigned to investigations. He has meddled in Bowling, and Swimming and continues to be active in police athletics and local, state, and national level.

He has won two silver medals and one gold medal on the Pistol Team. He is also the President of the Alameda County DSA Pistol Team. Almost everyone in Police Athletics in California, the United States, and many foreign countries knows Bob Burke. He has been a mainstay for the CPAF and is extremely devoted to the Police Olympics and sports in general. Bob is the Athletic Director for LAPD and has been with the Police Olympics since its beginning and is a founding member of the CPAF. He coordinated the Police Olympics in Los Angeles in 1973. Bob and his wife Sue live in Glendale; they have two children Kim (22) and Kevin (19). Sue teaches second grade at Mountain Avenue School in La Crescenta. Bob holds gold medals in Pistol, Decathlon, and Pentathlon. He was also a weightlifter during the 1967 Police Olympics. Bob has been a member of LAPD Long Distance Relay Team: Mexico to Canada 1972; Washington, D.C. to Los Angeles, 1974; Los Angeles to Montreal, Quebec, 1976; as well as the Long Beach to San Diego Relay Team.

Joe is the physical training instructor for the San Francisco Police Department. He has been with that department since 1965 and competed in the 1967 Police Olympics. He is also a founder of the CPAF and has served as past president. Joe also coordinated the 1971 California Police Olympics and the 1974 International Police Olympics held in San Francisco. Joe's family consists of his wife Pat. Joe has won gold and silver medals in Judo and Wrestling; won a gold medal in Wrestling at the National Police Olympics in Tulsa, Oklahoma in 1972. He has also meddled in track. In addition to the Police Olympics, Joe is heavily involved in PAL Judo.

Joe is currently involved in sponsoring long distance running events and the Special Olympics on behalf of the San Francisco Police Department and will coordinate the 1982 California Police Olympics in San Francisco.

Duke is the founder of the California Police Olympics, coordinating the first games in 1967 in San Diego. He is a founding member of the CPAF and is the first president of the newly formed National Police Athletic Federation. Duke's family consists of his wife Mary Towns, and three grown boys: Erich, Mark, and Phillip. Duke has been with the San Diego Police Department for 25 years.

Archery is Duke's main athletic interest. He won his first Police Olympic gold medal in 1977; but has five silver, including one from the 1974 International Police Olympics, and three bronze medals. He began his archery career in 1950 at Arizona State University in Tempe, Arizona; where he still retains archery records. Duke runs for physical conditioning and was on the second place Masters 400 Meter Relay Team last year.

Lee was in charge of physical training with the LASD Academy. He was a 25-year veteran with that department, having joined in 1953. Lee and his wife Robbie have two daughters, Kim (25) and Sherry (27), and three grandchildren. Robbie is active in real estate sales. Lee entered his first Police Olympics in 1968 and became a Director of the CPAF in 1974. Since then, he has won gold medals in the Masters Mile, 4-Mile, 6-Mile, Marathon, and Mile Relay. His 19 member team still holds the record of the mile relay. Lee has silver medals for Handball Doubles, 3-Mile Run, Mile Run, and Mile Relay; bronze medals for the 440 and the 3-Mile Runs.

Other accomplishments claimed by Lee Stahl are a National Masters AAU Marathon time of 2:51 hours; a Third place National 10 km run in 33:17 minutes; member of the LASD Long Beach to San Diego Relay Team; and played baseball with the Corpus Christi, Texas team of the Cleveland Indian chain. Lee is also a Navy veteran of five years service.

Bob has been an investigator for the Orange County D.A. for 8½ years, prior to which he was with the Garden Grove Police Department for 6 years.

Bob and his wife Nancy have one daughter, Rhonda (9). Bob joined the Board of Directors of the CPAF in 1975. He has competed in the Police Olympics since 1968, having participated in 440 Relay, 1500 Meter Run, Decathlon, Cycling, Bowling, Billiards, and Tennis.

Bob served as president through 1980 and contributed significantly to the success of the CPAF and the Police Olympics Program.

CPAF BOARD OF DIRECTORS

During the 1976 California Police Olympics held in San Jose, the Board of Directors of the CPAF became known to many for the first time. The Directors realized that as the Police Olympics continued to grow, more and more problems were developing during the games. Many of these problems required police decisions to be made by this group rather than the host agency.

A Federation room was opened and manned by one or more of the Directors each day. Questions were answered, protests received and acted upon, and in general, the Board members tried to be of service to anyone who stopped by.

Every year a Federation room is opened and in addition to answering questions, receiving complaints and protests, we received the results directly from the event coordinators. The purpose of receiving results in this manner was to mail to those participants who had signed up to receive them and to publish a CPAF newsletter.

When was the Federation founded?

The CPAF was founded in 1968, shortly after the first Police Olympics were held in San Diego. A meeting was held at the Los Angeles Police Academy and interested officers from throughout the State attended. Corporation papers were drawn up shortly after that meeting and a non-profit corporation was formed.

What is the purpose of the CPAF?

The prime functions of the CPAF are to plan for and perpetuate the California Police Olympics, to encourage physical fitness, and to promote athletic competition among police officers throughout the State.

What salary do the Directors receive and where does the money come from?

CPAF Directors receive no remuneration of any kind. Their contribution to police athletics is all voluntary. Expenses incurred for the attendance at meetings and for CPAF business is reimbursed. This money comes from a portion of each entry fee that is paid to the Federation by the organization hosting each year's Olympics.

How often are meetings of the CPAF held?

There are currently three regular meetings held annually with special meetings called when necessary. One meeting is held at the site of the next year's Police Olympics; this meeting is held to completely critique the past year's games and to give the next host agency some insight into problems that can be expected. Also, at this meeting, the Police Olympic's site for the second year following is selected. Any organization that

is interested submits a bid, and the Board of Directors votes on the final selection. The second meeting is held in May or June, just prior to the Police Olympics for the purpose of assisting the host agency with problems they may have encountered, viewing sites to determine their adequacy; and, in general, satisfying the Board of Directors that the Police Olympics can be held successfully. A third regular meeting is held on the day prior to the Police Olympics to resolve any matters pending that require CPAF action.

What is the authority of the CPAF?

The CPAF has final authority in any matter concerning the California Police Olympics. All procedures, rules, and regulations are established by the CPAF. Even though events may be governed by such organizations such as the AAU, NRA, CCA, these rules may be altered or revised in some manner by the CPAF. The only purpose for such a revision would be to adjust to the needs of police officers and would be made with the best interest of the Police Olympics in mind.

How is it possible to organize and coordinate a program the size of the Police Olympics without a paid staff?

Only so long as the Directors of the Board of the CPAF have the best interests of athletics and police athletes in mind and are willing to devote the time and energy necessary to do the job will the volunteer organization continue to be successful. Police athletes contribute to this success by providing the funds for the CPAF to operate. A portion of these funds also go to pay entry fees and to provide a team jacket for the California team going to the National or International Police Olympics.
