## CALIFORNIA POLICE ATHLETIC FEDERATION

### What is the California Police Athletic Federation (CPAF)?

The California Police Athletic Federation is a non-profit corporation composed of nine members of the Board of Directors, representing all sections of the State of California. The State has been divided into four sections so that representation can be had from officers living in the section he represents.

### CPAF BOARD OF DIRECTORS

During the 1976 California Police Olympics held in San Jose, the Board of Directors of the CPAF became known to many for the first time. The Directors realized that, as the Police Olympics continued to grow, more and more problems were developing during the games. Many of these problems required policy decisions to be made by this group rather than the host agency.

A Federation room was opened and manned by one or more of the Directors each day. Questions were answered, protests received and acted upon and, in general, the Board members tried to be of service to anyone who stopped by.

Every year a Federation room is opened and, in addition to answering questions, receiving complaints and protests, results were received directly from the event coordinators. The purpose of receiving results in this manner was to publish the Police Olympian and mail a copy to all participants.

### When was the Federation founded?

The CPAF was founded in 1968, shortly after the first Police Olympics was held in San Diego. A meeting was held at the Los Angeles Police Academy and interested officers from throughout the State attended. Corporation papers were drawn up shortly after that meeting and a non-profit corporation was formed.

### What is the purpose of CPAF?

The prime functions of the CPAF are to plan for and perpetuate the California Police Olympics, to encourage physical fitness, and to promote athletic competition among police officers throughout the State.

### What salary do the Directors receive and where does the money come from?

CPAF Directors receive no remuneration of any kind. Their contribution to police athletics is all voluntary. Expenses incurred for the attendance at meetings and for CPAF business are reimbursed. This money comes from a portion of each entry fee.

### How often are meetings of the CPAF held?

There are currently three regular meetings held annually with special meetings called when necessary. One meeting is held at the site of the next year's Police Olympics; this meeting is held to completely critique the past year's games and to give the next host agency some insight into problems that can be

expected. Also, at this meeting, the Police Olympic's site for the second year following is selected. Any organization that is interested submits a bid, and the Board of Directors votes on the final selection. The second meeting is held in May or June, just prior to the Police Olympics for the purpose of assisting the host agency with problems they may have encountered, viewing sites to determine their adequacy; and, in general, satisfying the Board of Directors that the Police Olympics can be held successfully. A third regular meeting is held on the day prior to the Police Olympics to resolve any matters pending that require CPAF action.

What is the authority of the CPAF?

The CPAF has final authority in any matter concerning the California Police Olympics. All procedures, rules, and regulations are established by the CPAF. Even though events may be governed by such organizations as the TAC, NRA, NCAA, these rules may be altered or revised in some manner by the CPAF. The only purpose for such a revision would be to adjust to the needs of police officers and would be made with the best interest of the Police Olympics in mind.

How is it possible to organize and coordinate a program the size of the Police Olympics without a paid staff?

Only so long as the Directors of the Board of the CPAF have the best interests of athletics and police athletes in mind and are willing to devote the time and energy necessary to do the job will the volunteer organization continue to be successful. Police athletes contribute to this success by providing the funds for the CPAF to operate.



Steve Garvey, outstanding first baseman for the San Diego Padres, has been selected by the Board of Directors of the California Police Athletic Federation to be the first Honorary Chairman of the CPAF ASSOCIATES and the World Police and Fire Games.

Steve has been a long-time supporter of law enforcement and learned of the Police Olympics through a friend, Lt. Bob Jones of the San Diego Police Department, who has competed in and coordinated Police Olympic events. Steve's enthusiasm to become a part of this program soared.

Steve Garvey's ability to excel as an athlete goes back to 1966 when he was named Athlete of the Year at Chamberlain High School in Tampa, Florida. He was drafted by the Minnesota Twins out of high school, but chose not to sign. Instead, he entered Michigan State, where he played football and became an All-American baseball player. In June of 1968, Steve became the Dodgers #1 selection in the Free Agent Draft.

Steve has six 200 hit seasons to his credit, which is exceeded by only seven players in major league history: Pete Rose (10), Ty Cobb (9), Lou Gehrig (8), Willie Keeler (8), Paul Waner (8), Charles Gehringer (7) and Roger Hornsby (7).

The Directors of the California Police Athletic Federation are extremely pleased to include Steve Garvey on "the team". His presence can only result in a greater opportunity to improve the California Police Olympics and other police athletic competitions.

CALIFORNIA POLICE ATHLETIC FEDERATION  
RULE CHANGES OR CLARIFICATION FOR 1983

TEAM SPORTS - The following team sports may have a sworn, non-playing coach who must also submit an application and pay fees: BASKETBALL, SOCCER, SOFTBALL FASTPITCH, SOFTBALL SLOPITCH, 6-MAN VOLLEYBALL and TUG-OF-WAR.

ARCHERY - The bowhunter event has both barebow and freestyle classification.

ARMWRESTLING - Open, Senior, and Master in all weights for Mens and Womens events.

BOWLING - Mens and Womens Singles and Doubles only have "A" and "B" Divisions. "B" is bowlers with a current league average of 169 or less who elect to bowl "B" AND who submit on their application the phone number of that league secretary AND who's average can be verified with that league secretary at that phone number (expect your average to be verified). "A" is for everyone else. Bowlers must help police themselves so that "B" Division is legitimate.

BOXING - All boxers must make the weight indicated on their application.

CYCLING - Masters class in all events.

DIVING - Scratched.

GOLF - 2-man team scoring is better ball scoring. Ties will be played off on course unless the course is not available to the host agency or due to darkness, in which case they will be decided off the score card of the last day's competition, beginning with the first hole.

JUDO - KATA, Open event (women may compete).

KARATE - KATA, Open event with weapons (women may compete). Open event, no weapons - hardstyle only (women may compete).

MOTOCROSS - Add Fourstroke (all cc) Open, Senior, Master. All classes, two 20-minute motos unless air temperature is over 100 degrees F.; then motos will be 15 minutes.

OVER-THE-LINE - Will be a temporary sport for San Diego only.

POCKET BILLIARDS - Scoring, preliminary matches are played to 100 points, semi-finals to 125, finals to 150.

POWERLIFTING - Lifters should make weight specified on application. Weigh-ins will begin two hours before competition. At that time, lots will be drawn to determine weigh-in sequence. Weigh-ins will be in secret. Results will not be made known until all weigh-ins (and re-weighs) are finished. Master or Senior lifters may elect to lift in a younger age division only if so indicated on their application. Before or during competition no changes in age division will be made from that listed on the application.

SAILING - Open multi-hull is 21' and under (except Hobie 16s).

SKIN DIVING - Scratched.

SWIMMING - Host agency may elect to run prelims in larger events. \$5.00 fee for each event over 4 listed on application.

TRACK & FIELD - All events have all age divisions, Open, Senior, Master. Add separate Mens and Womens divisions in Discus and Javelin. Add Men/Womens combined triple jump. Decathlon Rules IAAF. \$5.00 fee for each event over 4 listed on the application.

TRIATHLON - 1-mile swim, 25-mile cycling, 10K run, in that order.


VOLLEYBALL - Add mixed 4-person teams, 2 men and 2 women (6 total on team).

WATERSKIING - In Open division, short line after complete pass at 32 MPH (still).

WRESTLING - Guiding bodies are now FILA and CPAF (2-3 min. rounds - 4 pt. system).

ALL SPORTS - Gambling and drinking during competition are not allowed.
