Terry first participated in the Police Olympics in 1983. Terry has competed in Triathlon, Open Water Swim, Racquetball, Dragonboat, Swimming and Indoor Rowing. Terry has earned 25 medals in the Police Olympics, California Police Summer Games and the United States Police

and Fire Championships. Terry has competed in four World Police and Fire Games including the inaugural event in 1985 winning four Gold medals in those competitions. Terry organized Oceanside Police Department's first Baker 2 Vegas team in 1987 and remained Team Captain for five years. While attending the FBI National Academy in 1995 he was awarded the Director's Medal for swimming 106 miles in 9 weeks. Terry has run 30 Triathlons, 9 Marathons, and two 50-mile Ultramarathons! Terry is a certified Indoor Rowing instructor training Police and Fire personnel interested in competing in the USPFC. Terry was a member of Team USA Dragon Boat National Team in 2013 competing in the International Dragon Boat Federation World Games. Terry goes above and beyond as an ambassador for the sport of Indoor Rowing by training prospective athletes and promoting the Games as an official Ambassador for the United States Police and Fire Championships. Terry has been a great role model and motivator throughout his competitive career.

Terry has set USPFC records for Indoor Rowing in his age and weight class for 500 Meters, 2000 Meters in 2015, 2016, and 2019 including Doubles records with his partner and fellow Hall of Fame inductee Georgiana Lea Browning.

Terry's law enforcement career began in 1972 as a Police Officer with Rock Island P.D. Terry served with Oceanside P.D. in California from 1982 through 1997 in a variety of key positions. Terry became Chief of Police in Banning, California until 2001 where his career came full circle when he became Chief of Rock Island Police Department, Illinois.
