"\*If the 40+ women's doubles division does not have a minimum of 5 teams, WPFG reserves the right to combine the division with 18+."

Active competitors from police, fire and eligible first responder agencies may combine to form a team regardless of agency is WITHIN A COUNTRY





Retired competitors may combine to form a team in any manner they wish with other eligible competitors whether police or fire. This includes cross country lines.

#### Officials

All games will be officiated by 1 qualified referee. Orthye team captains can talk to the referee. Questions must be asked in a respectful manner and not done repeatedly to delay the game.

The Sport Coordinator will be consulted for any disputes not resolved by the referee.

#### Medical

A trained first aid, ora medical practitioner, will be present during all matches. Basic medical supplies will be available at the venue. Communications will be available at each venue and preparations made in case it is necessary to summon emergency services.

## **Sport Equipment**

Players may not wear apparel which can cause injury to another person.

Penalty Procedure: The player must remove any such articles before playing or when noticed. If a player does not comply with a referee's request, that player's team will be disqualified.

No metal spikes or cleats are allowed.

# **Competition Format**

#### Bracketing

Men's Doubles: Group Play preliminaries followed by a Double Elimination Finals.

Women's Doubles and Mixed Doubles: Group Play preliminaries followed by Single Elimination Finals.

**Exception:** For Events with seven or less teams, all teams will remain in one group (one Division for Men's) and places will be decided by Group Play.





# **Scheduling**

Scheduled for 5 days of competition. Sesport Schedule for details.

Day 1: Men's Doubles-Group Play

Day 2: Men's Doubles-Double Elimination

Day 3: Men's Doubles-Finals

Women's Doubles

Day 4: Mixed Doubles

Day 5: If needed

## **Awards**

Medals are awarded First through Third Place (1s8rd).

# **Sport Rules**

No substitutions permitted during a game. If a player is unable to continue playing or remain on the court during play, that team will forfeit the game.

Weather, Darkness, or Other \*\*Exardous Condition(s): Play will be suspended if any hazardous safety condition exists.

#### **Competitor Attire**

Players may not wear apparel which can cause injury to another person. Penalty Procedure: The player must remove any such articles before playingwhen noticed. If a player fails to comply with a referee's request, that player's team will be disqualified.

No metal spikes or cleats are allowed.

#### Mixed Doubles

Net Height: 7' 4 1/8" (2.24 meters) Men can not block at the net Women can block any time at the net





Two hits off of block Switch sides every 7 points





#### Mens and Womens Doubles

No open hand 'dinks'
Rotation of serves required, positional rotation optional
Two hits only, off block
Net Height for Men: 7' 11 5/8" (2.43 meters)

Net Height for Women: 7' 4 1/8" (2.24 meters)

Switch sides every 7 points

# **Pre Competition Meeting**

Prior to the start of competition, a meeting will be held between the referees and the captain or coach from each participating team to clarify rules and conduct of play. Details of this meeting will be shared in the Sport Confirmation Letter.

## **Players Conduct**

Any serious violation of conduct, such as fighting or violence toward players or officials will result in the player(s) immediate ejection from that game and her automatic suspension from his/her team's next scheduled game. The sport coordinator shall immediately notify the WPFGF, who will investigate each incident to determine if additional discipline will be imposed.
