Team Event

A team consists of a maximum of 4 runners (best three scores to count). At least 3 team members must complete the course for the team to be eligible for medals. The aggregate score of the best three times determines the Team score. If a placing team has four team members, the fourth team member may only receive a medal if he/she ~~starts~~ starts the race.

In order to run on a Team, competitors must also enter the Individual event. Competitors in both events are scored by the result of one race.

Active competitors from police, fire and eligible first responder agencies may combine to form a team regardless of agency size **WITHIN A COUNTRY**

Retired competitors may combine to form a team in any manner they wish with other eligible competitors whether police or fire. This includes across country lines.

Sport Rules

General Sport Rules

All Competitors will be provided a bib with a number.

Once a starting time has been established, it will not be changed except to adjust it later in case of hazardous conditions.

The course will have water stops every mile.

Players Conduct

Any serious violation of conduct, such as fighting or violence toward other participants or officials will result in the participants immediate disqualification from the competition. The sport coordinator shall immediately notify the WPFGE, who will investigate each incident to determine if additional discipline will be imposed.
