Retired competitors may combine to form a team in any manner they wish with other eligible competitors whether police or fire. This includes cross country lines.

### **Medical**

Basic medical supplies will be available at the venue.

Communications will be also available at the venue and preparations made in case it is necessary to summon emergency services.

## **Competition Format**

### **Bracketing**

**Round Robin** - To determine Men's 18+ A & B Divisions followed by single elimination finals.

Men's 40+, Women's and Mixed Doubles - round robin to determine which competitor/teams proceed to the single elimination final.

Singles and Doubles should be held on separate days (consecutive) and completed on that same day. Play should begin at 0900 hours each day; 15 minute grace periods before forfeiture.

### **Scheduling**

Scheduled for 3 days. See [Sport Schedule](#) for dates.

### **Awards**

Medals are awarded First through Third Place (1st - 3rd).

### **Scoring**

Best 3 of 5 games to 11 points (with a 2 point advantage).
