- Mixed (3 Person) Team (must have minimum 1 man and 1 woman)

- Men (3 Person) Team
  - Age categories: 18 +, 30 +, 40 +, & 50 +
- Women (3 Person) Team

Active competitors from police, fire, and eligible first responder agencies may combine to form a team regardless of agency size **WITHIN A COUNTRY** 



Retired competitors may combine to form a team in any manner they wish with other eligible competitors whether police, fire, or eligible first responders. This includes across country lines.

#### A competitor may enter only one sport event in the Team Triathlon

#### Officials

The Triathlon will be officiated by a head referee, referees in each phase of the race, and race marshals. A head timer will collect and process all data and scores.

#### **Entry Deadline**

July 15, 2023

#### **Medical**

An EMT and Ambulance shall be **onite** during the competition. Lifeguards will also be present on the water. Basic medical supplies will be available at the venue. Communications will be available at each venue, and preparations will be made if necessary to summon additional emergency services.

#### **Race Headquarters**

Will be located near the Medical Headquarters within the Finish Line area.

#### **Public Address System**

A public address system will be located in the start/finish/transition area. Race information including start/finish, race updates, awards and general announcements will be broadcast over the public address system in English.

Total times of all three phases, "with transitions included." Splits should be recorded.

#### **Sport Equipment**

Each athlete is responsible for their personal sport equipment.



Swim Caps will be provided by the Host.

Numbers will be issued according to age groups, each age group with a different colored background. Athletes' numbers will be written on the lateral side of both legs and both upper arms.

#### **Body Markings**

• All competitor categories will be marked on their right calves, along with customary race numbering on shoulders, etc. Those competing in the Team event will be marked with a "T" above the category.

#### Awards

Medals are awarded First through Third Place (lst-3rd).

# **Sport Rules**

**Olympic Triathlon:** An Olympic triathlon consists of a 1.5km swim, 40km bike phase, and 10km run.

All competitors will check in at the venue at least 1 hour before starting time using their Athlete Accreditation. (See WPFGGeneral Rules).

Each team will consist of three members. Each team will have one team wristband, which must be passed from one team member to another as the relay progresses. Winning teams will be the teams whose runners cross the finish line first. A team competitor may only compete in one of the three segments of the Triathlon.

Team members other than runners are not to cross the finish line.

Competitors may only compete in **<u>one</u>** event. <u>Examples</u>: An Individual event competitor may <u>**not**</u> swim the first segment of the Team event. A Men's Team swimmer may <u>**not**</u> also swim the first segment of the Mixed Team event.

All competitors who cannot complete the entire race or their phase of the team event for any reason must check in with a race official as soon as possible.



There will be a mandatory pre-race meeting held the night/afternoon before the race. At this time, all relevant information regarding the course, rules, etc., will be given to competitors.

Weigh-in for the Heavyweight categories will be at the prerace meeting the day before the event. Male and female entrants in the Heavyweight categories will be weighed in a bathing suit and bare feet.

#### **Players Conduct**

Any serious violation of conduct, sub as fighting or violence toward other participants or officials will result in the participants immediate disqualification from the competition. The sport coordinator shall immediately notify the WPFGF, who will investigate each incident to determine if additional discipline will be imposed.
