The Guiding Bodies are the United States Police & Fire Championships and the American Cornhole Organization (ACO).

Conduct Expected of ALL Participants:

Drinking of alcoholic beverages, unlawful consumption of controlled substances, and gambling is prohibited while competing. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be condoned either before, during, or after competition. Any physical or verbal assaults on officials, competitors, spectators, coordinators or ex-officios will be met **with IMMEDIATE AND SEVERE PENALTIES**, including **EXPULSION** from these and future United States Police & Fire Championships.

Athletes may use their own bags as long as they conform to American Cornhole League (ACL) and American Cornhole Organization (ACO) regulations. You must have your bags approved prior to the beginning of competition. USPFCH will have a limited number of bags available for use during the event.

Bracketing:

Tournament formatting will be based on the number of teams registered. Pool play of 4 person/team groupings followed by a Double Elimination Tournament. The top two in each pool will advance to the "A" Flight and the bottom two will advance to the "B" Flight. Medals will be awarded to both Flights.

Scoring:

Traditional 21: The game will be played to the pre-determined twenty-one (21) points. The first team to reach (or exceed) that amount at the conclusion of a frame is the winner.

- Woody-Any Cornhole bag that has been pitched and remains on the board at the conclusion of the frame. Worth 1 point
- Cornhole-Any Cornhole bag that has been pitched and passes through the Cornhole board at any time within the frame. Worth 3 points

Cancellation Scoring: The approved method of scoring for the sport of Cornhole is "cancellation" scoring. In cancellation scoring, the points of one player cancel out the points of their opponent. Using this method, only one player/team can score in each frame.
